

Immunization Record Card Information

Did you know...

Michigan's public health code requires all health care professionals to provide a record of each immunization that was administered to the parent, guardian or person presenting the child for care. Information that should be included is the name of vaccines, the date they were given and whether further doses are indicated.

An Official State of Michigan Immunization Record can be printed directly from the Michigan Care Improvement Registry (MCIR). Prior to printing, double check, that the vaccines documented in the patient's chart are documented in MCIR.
