Nurses can obtain continuing education credits for reading the *AIM Provider Tool Kit!* Fill out the form below and receive up to four credit hours!

The Michigan Public Health Code and board administrative rules require every nurse to complete, during the 2-year period prior to the expiration of their license, not less than 25 hours of continuing education in courses or programs approved by the Board. Pursuant to this requirement, the Board of Nursing has promulgated rules to establish specific criteria for the Board's approval of continuing education courses and programs.

Continuing Education Requirements for Michigan Nurses Rule 2(i)

A maximum of **four credit hours** may be earned by reading articles or viewing or listening to media devoted to nursing practice. If audited, the licensee must submit a letter listing complete references for the article read and/or the title and specific focus of the nursing practice media program reviewed.*
